All non-commercial boats must dock at the camping dock located at Beachy Cove.


All visitors to the island must have a valid Fathom Five park day pass.

Main washrooms are located at Beachy Cove. Additional washrooms are located at the lighthouse and at the campground dock.

Hiking Distances from Beachy Cove

Flowerpots:
700 meters (15 minutes)

Cave:
800 meters (20 minutes)

Lightstation:
1.3 Kilometers (30 minutes)

Full Loop Trail:
1.4 Kilometers (2.5 hours)

Marl Trail:
800 meters (20 minutes)
