

### **Filming Permit Application Form**

Under the terms of the *Historic Canals Regulations* (DORS/93-220), any activity on the Parks Canada waterways must have obtained a prior approval. This approval takes the form of a filming permit.

#### About the form

Use this form to apply for a filming permit. This permit is required to carry out a film shooting on land or on the waters of one of the Parks Canada historic canals in Quebec (Lachine Canal, Chambly Canal, Saint-Ours Canal, Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue Canal, Carillon Canal).

Please note that submitting this form does not constitute an approval of your film shooting. A minimum non-refundable application fee of \$153.50 (taxes included) is required.

### How to complete the form

- 1- Make sure you have correctly completed all the fields before submitting you application. Mandatory fields are indicated by an asterisk (\*).
- 2- Once it is completed, you can send the form to the following address:

We will evaluate your application and a follow-up will be done on the documents and approvals required before issuing the filming permit. Parks Canada does not assume any responsibility for the commitments made by the applicant to a third party in the event of a refused application.

#### Land user fees and public liability and damage insurance

At least one week before the start of the filming, you must obtain and submit a proof of insurance with a minimum value of \$2,000,000 (coverage for public liability and damage) with reference to His Majesty the King, in right of Canada, as represented by the Minister of Environment for the purpose for the Parcs Canada Agency as co-insuree. A higher coverage may be required depending on the risk level of the project.

The application will be assessed to determine the land and/or additional service user fees when all the required documents have been received. Details of the costs will be communicated to the applicant after acceptance of the application. 100% of the land user fees are reinvested directly in the sites.
